



Finding your Laptop Battery Part number/Model.

Method 01 – By battery model number (Recommended)



Try to locate the model number on the laptop battery. Different laptop brands have different terms and displayed in different locations however you will be able to find it because the battery model number will be in big bold letters. In some brands model is spelled as a module.

E.g. PA3534U-1BRS, AS07A71

Method 02 – By battery HSTN number, type number or the spare number



This method is common with HP, Dell and MacBooks. You would need to find the battery HSTNN number or the Battery type number or the spare number.

E.g. HSTNN-LB40, Type J1KND, HP replace spare number 484171-001

Method 03 – By the laptop model



This method is not recommended however if you are having trouble of finding battery model or the part number you can provide us the laptop model number. With our thousands of model number database we will be able to find your battery model. Locate model or the module backside of the laptop as shown below.

E.g HP Pavilion DV6, Aspire 4930g

Method 04 – By the laptop model



On some brands you can't find any information or a model number on the back side of the laptop. If you are having the same troubles try to locate the model number on your laptop keyboard or the screen frame area. In most cases you will be able to find something big and bold.

E.g Lenovo T430, Dell Studio 1535

Method 05 – By the laptop model (For Advanced users)



We don't recommend this option if you don't have good computer skills. To find your model from the laptop you would need to go to Dos mode before boot up the PC. Then you can locate a Tab called "Information" or "About" to find the model number. Some brands will display the model or the series number before the

windows welcome screen.

e.g. Power Edge M710, Dell Studio 1735
